COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Mrs. McCoy spoke about Mr. Cimino's attributes – he works long hours and is very dedicated to the students and staff at Central School. New Board members may not be familiar with some of the positives that Mr. Cimino has brought to the district, such as the implementation of the emergency call system and the gradebook program that Central teachers have used. He knows the students well and spends a great deal of time being available for them and for the teachers. She wished the Board would consider not accepting his resignation.

RESOLUTIONS

Mr. Meringolo stated that it is always difficult to replace senior staff members and Mr. Cimino will be difficult to replace.

- Accepted the resignation of Richard Cimino from the position of Principal of Central School effective September 30, 2009.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Mrs. Harrington asked about the search process for a new principal. Dr. Rovtar stated that because the Board views this as an important decision they would like to have adequate time to conduct a search. Since Mr. Cimino has given the district 60 days notice, it is unlikely that a reasonable search could be conducted in that short time. The Board will advertise and appoint an interim principal to manage the school while the principal search is conducted.
